BACKGROUND

The Clerk's Office has received correspondence from Larry Scanlan who has been the Police Service Board representative appointed by the Town since March 2011. This correspondence is his request for re appointment to the Board for this term of Council. Town Council are required to appoint one member from Tillsonburg and the Province of Ontario appoint two additional representatives from Tillsonburg.

During this past term of Council Larry Scanlan sat as Chair of the Police Service Board and Greg Horvath and Ann Locker were Board members appointed by the Province. The Town is responsible for paying these members a stipend. The Town also provides a Board secretary who receives a stipend for that service.
