RECOMMENDATION

THAT Council receives report FIN 22-27 2023 Capital Pre-Budget Approvals;

AND THAT pre-budget approval for the following 2023 Operations & Development and Recreation, Culture and Parks projects be granted:

X11	Young Street Storm/Water/Sanitary/Surface Reconstruction	\$ 2,432,300
X40	Townline Storm Construction	\$ 254,000
X28	Arena Dehumidifier	\$ 155,000

BACKGROUND

Staff will present the 2023 Capital & Operating Budgets for Council's consideration at the December 7th Council Budget meeting. Included in the 2023 Capital Budget are projects which may benefit from immediate action. These projects include project X11 Young Street Storm/Water/Sanitary/Surface Reconstruction, X40 Townline Storm Construction, and X28 Arena Dehumidifier.

DISCUSSION

An advantage of providing early Capital project approval is that this permits for both better planning and costing. Furthermore, the additional time period of almost two months allows staff, applicable user groups, and contractors to prepare for the impact of these projects. In particular, the Arena Dehumidifier may take up to 12 months for delivery, and it would be prudent to order right away.

Specific project details relating to each of the identified Capital projects is contained within the detailed project sheets of the budget binders and at a summary level within the Capital Summary in the budget binder.

All Town departments were consulted for any required pre-approvals in their respective budget areas.
