To the Mayor and council,

Three months ago I addressed council and proposed building an all-season tennis, pickle ball and basket ball arena over the existing tennis courts. With your November budget comming up it is essential that this project gets attention.

Our town is expanding rapidly and facilities for indoor sports does not exist. Woodstock, Delhi, Aylmer, Ingersol all have indoor arenas for accommodating tennis and pickle ball yet Tillsonburg is way behind.

I left your engineering department a full portfolio of names, construction companies and grants. The existing tennis courts need resurfacing so why not incorporate it into an all-season arena open mornings, afternoons and evenings twelve months of the year.

The cost of under one million is far short of the momey spent on the outdoor pool whilch is only open for three months weather permitting.

I trust this will not fall on deaf ears. This will be a paying project which not only will benefit the town but the residents of surrounding townships. The addition of tennis facilities for Glendale high school all winter should cover the needs of their sports programs.

I look forward to hearing positive discussions and results, as this facility is way overdue.
