

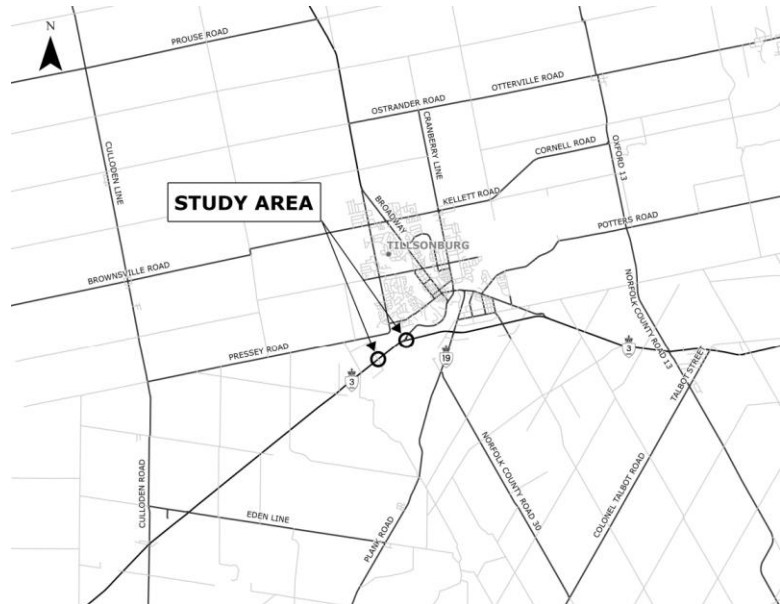
Notice of Study Commencement Class Environmental Assessment Study for Intersection Improvements to Highway 3 at Clearview Drive/Innovation Way and John Pound Road

The Corporation of the Town of Tillsonburg is initiating a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) study that will evaluate intersection upgrades to Highway 3 at Clearview Drive/Innovation Way and John Pound Road, within the Town of Tillsonburg (refer to the Study Area map).

The study is being initiated in accordance with the planning and design process for Group 'B' projects under the *Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities and Municipal Expressways (2024)*, approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

The Class EA study will involve:

- Identifying and evaluating alternative solutions for improving Highway 3 at:
 - Clearview Drive/Innovation Way; and
 - John Pound Road;
- Selecting preferred solutions for transportation improvements; and
- Evaluating and recommending a preferred design concept for the preferred solutions.



This notice signals the commencement of this Class EA which will define the project, identify and evaluate alternative solutions, and determine a preferred alternative solution in consultation with the public, Indigenous communities and regulatory agencies. Potential impacts of the proposed improvements on social, cultural, economic and natural environments will be considered and assessed during the Class EA.

Upon completion of this study, a Transportation Environmental Study Report (TESR) documenting the process will be submitted to the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation, and Parks and made available for public review for a period of 30 calendar days.

A key component of the study is consultation with interested stakeholders and members of the public. Your input during the planning process is encouraged.

Information collected will be used in accordance with the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*. With the exception of personal information, all comments will become part of the public record.
